

Summary of Changes to 2012 Woodcliff Rules & Regulations

Changes were made in the following rules for 2012:

Page 2 **General Regulation #2** addressing replacing sand which has been removed.

Page 3 **Property Maintenance #4** allowing 30 days instead of 20 days to repair washouts.

Page 5 **ATV/UTV Regulation #8b** changing the age to 12 to operate a UTV.

Page 5 **ATV/UTV Regulation #18** stating that liability insurance must be maintained for all ATV/UTVs etc.

Page 7 **Water Safety Regulation #16** designates that motorized boats must have life jackets on board for all occupants. Children under 13 must wear the life jacket at all times while underway. It is recommended that children under 13 wear a life jacket while aboard ANY watercraft.

Page 7 **Water Safety Regulation #20** changes the time that towables are allowed on weekend days and holidays: after 4pm on Sundays and after 6pm on Saturdays and holidays.

Page 7 **Water Safety Regulation #24** changes the age to under 27 for those that must be certified and carry certification for boater safety classes. No one under 16 may tow a skier or wake boarder and no one under 18 may tow an inflatable/towable device.

Page 8 **Water Safety Regulation #25** changes the time that jet skis may operate on weekend days and holidays: after 4pm on Sundays and after 6pm on Saturdays and holidays.

Page 8 **Water Safety Regulation #29** adds Lake Tirawa to the regulation that confines swimming and/or wading to within 25 feet of the shoreline and prohibits swimming to the island.

Page 10 **Violation Consequences and Fine Schedule**: The first sentence states that the first violation of a rule is given a verbal or written warning at the discretion of the officer. This puts in writing the current procedure.

Page 10 **The third paragraph, Violations of the Rules**, reduces the fine to \$50 for the first citation of a basic violation of the rules, which results in a reduction for the subsequent second and third offense also.

Page 11 **Violation of Water Safety Regulation #1** reduces the fine to \$100 for violation of the required yearly Woodcliff watercraft inspection.

These changes are highlighted and underlined to make it easier to locate. **The resulting changes have also been made on Page 12 Attachment 1 which is a summary of the restrictions by type of vehicle.** Please review each change in its entirety and make sure that all family and friends are aware of the changes to avoid an encounter with security.
