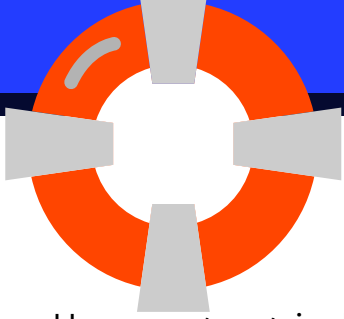

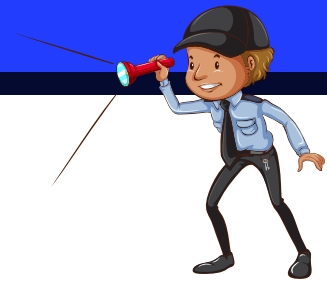

Security Update Summer 2023



Here we go again, heading into my 27th year at Woodcliff as your Chief of Security. To dispel in rumors, or maybe wishful thinking, I haven't retired, and I am still alive and kicking. As

usual we need to bring up the annual issues and reminders. The first of which is boat registrations. There have been some rule and penalty changes concerning the registration of your watercraft, or the consequences for not registering them before using them on the lake. I would encourage everyone to read the rules and familiarize themselves with any changes. As always this will be a priority enforcement issue. Please get your watercraft legal so we can avoid a negative experience out on the lake. Inspect your watercraft and ensure everything

required by the rules/ state law is onboard and serviceable. Make sure your State Registration numbers and Lot Numbers are in the right place and in contrasting color to the

boat so they can be seen. Make sure your PFDs are on board and in good condition, one for every person onboard, and remember anyone under the age of 13 must have the PFD's on when underway. Check your fire extinguishers and make sure they are in good condition.

The Boater Safety Courses are scheduled for May 13th & 20th, 9am to 3pm, at the Community

Center. The Security Patrol Boat is getting a face lift and some upgrades due to the engine giving up the ghost. Please do your best not to bounce off it with your jet skis this summer.

It has been an expensive project.

I have been getting a lot of questions regarding the use of the Platte River access for ATVs this year. Frankly, I have no earthly idea where the situation stands or if it will be resolved.

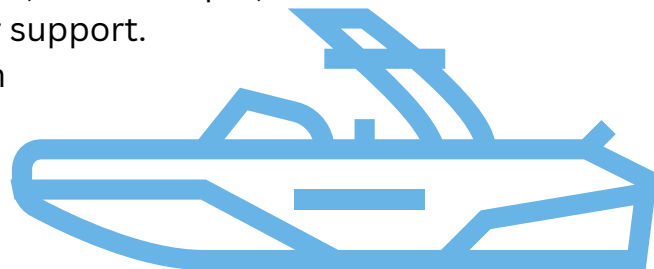
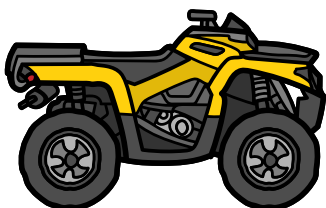
It is

the result of continuous trespassing issues on the adjoining hunting property, and residents not respecting the private property and driving their ATVs, UTVs, and vehicles through it, and ignoring the warnings to stay out. The result is going to be increased ATV traffic on our roads, which means an increase in complaints and enforcement action. Along with that will come

the inevitable increase in accidents and injuries. Please keep all of this in mind when using the roads around the lake this summer, stay on your toes and DRIVE CAREFULLY!!!! The ATV Safety Day will be Memorial Day Weekend, May 27th, 10am to 2pm, at the HOA office.

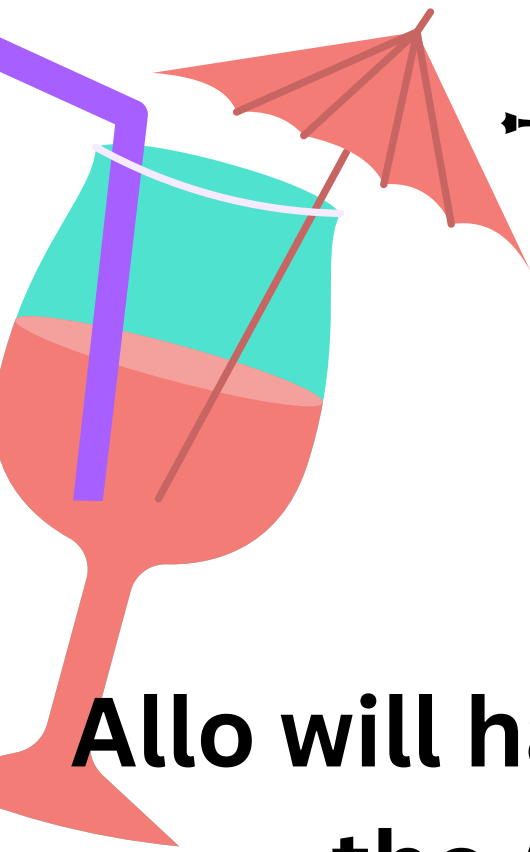

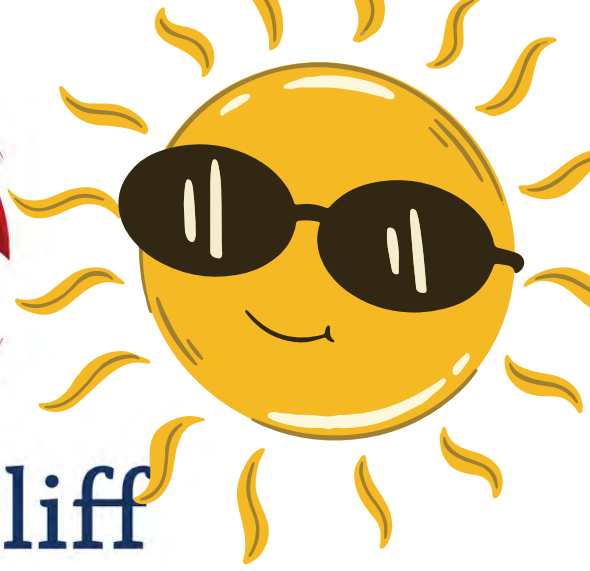

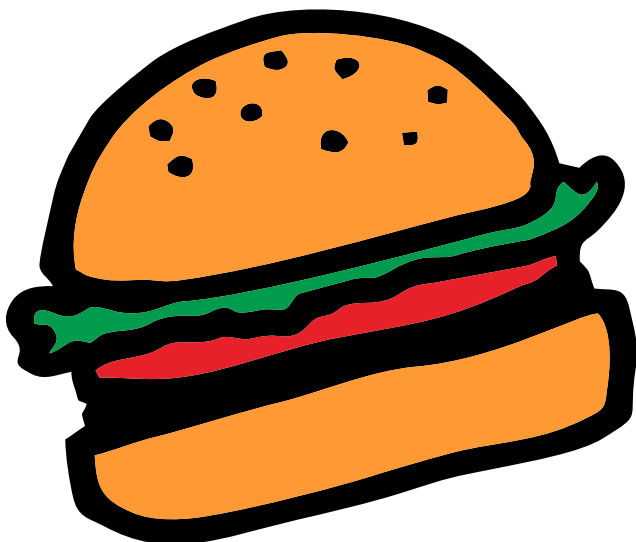
