

SECURITY UPDATE SPRING2023



IT HAS BEEN A LONG WINTER AND AS MUCH AS I ENIOY MY WINTERS AND OUIET TIME, I AM READY FOR SPRING. NO MAIOR CRIME TO REPORT OVER THE WINTER. DESPITE THE ACTIVITY IN THE SURROUNDING AREAS. THE SECURITY GATE AND CAMERAS DO AN AMAZING IOB OF KEEPING OUT THE UNDESIRABLES. AS WITH ALL ELECTRONICS, HOWEVER, THEY REQUIRE REGULAR MAINTENANCE AND OCCASIONAL UPGRADING. THAT BEING SAID. AND MOVING THE DVR/ ROUTER LOCATION TO A LOCATION THAT WILL ALLOW US TO TAP INTO THE SPECTRUM NETWORK, WHICH WILL BE FAR BETTER IN QUALITY. WE ARE WORKING WITH THE VENDORS, HOA, AND LIONS CLUB TO GET THE PROIECT COMPLETED. THE GATE. CAMERAS. AND ACTIVE PATROLLING ARE WHAT MAKES THE SECURITY PROGRAM WORK SO WELL AT WOODCLIFF. WE APPRECIATE YOUR SUPPORT IN THIS ENDEAVOR.

THE SEAGULLS ARE HERE, THEY WILL BE FOLLOWED BY THE CORMORANTS, THE PELICANS. AND THEN THE ROAR OF THE 1ET SKIS. ANOTHER SEASON IS OUICKLY APPROACHING. MAKE SURE YOUR STATE OF NEBRASKA REGISTRATION IS CURRENT AND IN THE PROPER LOCATION. MAKE SURE YOUR PFDS ARE ON BOARD AND IN SERVICEABLE CONDITION. CHECK THE FIRE EXTINGUISHERS AND MAKE SURE THEY ARE IN GOOD CONDITION. MAKE SURE YOUR ATVS STILL HAVE THE WOODCLIFF DECAL AND THE LOT NUMBER ON THEM. MAKE SURE TO REVIEW THE RULES WITH YOUR KIDS, AND GUESTS. THE BOATER SAFETY COURSE'S ARE SCHEDULED FOR MAY 13TH & 20TH. SATURDAY, AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER. ANYONE BORN AFTER DECEMBER 31ST, 1985 MUST HAVE THE BOATER SAFETY COURSE TO LEGALLY OPERATE A WATERCRAFT, AND THIS IS STRICTLY ENFORCED. GET ALL YOUR TOYS LEGAL AND LETS HAVE A SAFE AND ENIOYABLE SUMMER. AS ALWAYS. THANK YOU FOR YOUR SUPPORT, IT IS APPRECIATED.

This needs to be done before the boat is splashed in the Woodcliff Waters or Memorial day whichever comes first.

You can register on our website and stickers will be sent to you.

Please review 2023 Rules with new escalating fines.



PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

- Regular mowing of lawns and removal of weeds from beaches and lots shall mean that
 neither grass nor
 weeds shall exceed the height of one (1) foot.
- 2. Seawalls shall not be allowed to deteriorate to the degree that the mechanical functions shall be compromised. This shall include no materials missing nor falling, floating, or protruding into the lake. All repairs must be made within 30days of notice or as approved by the Board.
- 3. Docks and Shore Stations must be maintained to the extent that they are functional, safe, and usable. In the event of failure, repairs will be made or the item will be removed from the Lake within 30 days of notice or as approved by the board, and the property owner will be billed.
- 4. Washouts: The home owner is responsible for proper drainage on his property. The home owner must repair washouts, or make arrangements of said repair, within thirty (30) days of the event so as to prevent further sand from dumping into the Lake.
- 5. Trees on the owner's property must be trimmed to the extent that dead, damaged or split overhangs are removed from impingement onto adjoining properties and/or buildings within 30 days of being observed or identified.
- 6. Painting: A home that is showing neglect to the extent of 50% peeling paint, or absence of paint (excluding log homes), must be painted by the owner by the end of the season or at the beginning of the next. The season is defined as May 1st October 1st.
- 7. Rubbish, garbage, or junk shall be defined as unused, unwanted, broken, or unattended materials left or strewn about the property. This shall include, but is not limited to, glass, rags, paper, foodstuff, or metal. Homeowner shall remove such items within 7 days of notification by the Board.

Lot Number: Lot number must be displayed on watercraft using a contrasting color, measuring 3" in size on the back of both sides of watercraft. Personal Water Craft must display lot number on the rear of watercraft.

Required Equipment: Please be sure that the following equipment and documents are on the watercraft while underway: state registration, proof of insurance, boater safety certification for anyone under age 27, life jackets, fire extinguisher, throwable cushion flotation device, horn or whistle, paddle or oar, bailing bucket or bilge pump, working navigation lights, and orange flag for downed skiers.

The only numbers allowed on the front half

Residents on both streets can expect partial closure of roads during the construction. One lane of road should always be open for driving.


Temporary restrictions to your driveways during this project will happen and we hope to keep it to a minimum. The office will try to keep everyone updated to the time line of this project.






