### MINUTES OF SANITARY & IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 8 OF SAUNDERS COUNTY, NEBRASKA

On <u>AUGUST 31</u>, <u>2015</u> at <u>5:30</u> p.m., a Budget Hearing, Levy Hearing, Budget Meeting, and regular meeting of the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Sanitary & Improvement District No. 8 of Saunders County, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at the office of Woodcliff Lakes, Inc., Lot T-1018, Suite A, 980 County Road W, Fremont, Nebraska 68025.

Trustees present were: Lonnie Mahrt, Tom Sawyer, Nick Borman, Michael Wise, Sean Kenney

Trustees absent were: None

Others present were: Kent Speicher of Erickson & Brooks, Secretary Chris Johannesen, John Peterson of JEO Consulting, Duane Grashorn of PeopleService, Attorney Don Schneider, and Jay of JEO Consulting.

Timely notice of the meeting was given to the public by publication, notice and the proposed agenda was timely given to all members of the Board of Trustees, and notice was timely given to the Saunders County Clerk and the Fremont City Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in said notices. These minutes were written and available for public inspection at the office of Woodcliff Lakes, Inc., within ten working days or prior to the next convened meeting, whichever was earlier. It was stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and the location of the copy of said Act was indicated. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. Business conducted and decisions made were as follows.

#### Budget Hearing at 5:30pm.

The Budget Hearing was advertised in the Fremont Tribune. Chairman Lonnie Mahrt called the meeting to order.

Kent Speicher from Erickson & Brooks, CPA, went over the budget and assessment of the 2015-2016 fiscal year; past and future expenses and income were discussed. The need for an increase of 1% in restricted fund was discussed.

Whereupon a Motion for Adjournment of the Budget Hearing was made by Trustee Kenney, and seconded by Trustee Borman, and on roll call vote was unanimously approved by the Chairman and all trustees, and declared duly adopted by the Chairman, at which point the Budget Hearing adjourned.

### Levy Hearing at 5:35pm.

The Levy Hearing was advertised in the Fremont Tribune. Chairman Lonnie Mahrt called the meeting to order.

Kent Speicher went over the new valuations, discussion was had.

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Whereupon a Motion for Adjournment of the Levy Hearing was made by Trustee Wise, and seconded by Trustee Kenney, and on roll call vote was unanimously approved by the Chairman and all Trustees, and declared duly adopted by the chairman, at which point the Levy Hearing adjourned.

#### Meeting at 5:45pm.

The Meeting was advertised in the Fremont Tribune. Chairman Lonnie Mahrt called the meeting to order.

- 1. After the discussion of past expenses and next year's expected expenses, it was moved by Trustee Kenney and seconded by Trustee Borman to increase the restricted funds budget an additional one percent (1%) as allowed by state law. Upon roll call vote, voting YES were Trustees Borman, Kenney, Mahrt, Sawyer and Wise; voting NO were Trustees None; absent or abstaining were None; which was 100% of those present in favor and 100% of all Trustees in favor; whereupon the motion was declared adopted by the chairman.
- 2. Ordinance 2015-01, copy attached to these minutes, was then moved for adoption by Trustee Sawyer and seconded by Trustee Wise, said ordinance to adopt budget and waive the three readings for appropriations as otherwise required. Upon roll call vote, voting YES were Trustees Borman, Kenney, Mahrt, Sawyer and Wise; voting NO were Trustees None; absent or abstaining were None; whereupon the ordinance was declared adopted by the chairman.
- 3. Resolution 2015-01, copy attached to these minutes, was then moved for adoption by Trustee Kenney and seconded by Trustee Sawyer, said resolution to set the levy of the District for the 2015-2015 fiscal year at \$134,609 for the general fund, which is at a levy rate of 0.115116 per \$100 valuation; and at \$99,394 for the sinking fund, which is at a levy rate of 0.085000 per \$100 valuation. Upon roll call vote, voting YES were Trustees Borman, Kenney, Mahrt, Sawyer and Wise; voting NO were Trustees None; absent or abstaining were None; whereupon the resolution was declared adopted by the chairman.
- 4. It was moved by Trustee Borman and seconded by Trustee Sawyer that the District approved using the budget document as the audit waiver for the 2014-2015 fiscal year just completed. Upon roll call vote, voting YES were Trustees Borman, Kenney, Mahrt, Sawyer and Wise; voting NO were Trustees None; absent or abstaining were None; whereupon the motion was declared adopted by the chairman.
- 5. Annual statement of SID 8 status, copy attached to these minutes, was then moved for adoption, motion made by Trustee Sawyer and seconded by Trustee Kenney. Upon roll call vote, voting YES were Trustees Borman, Kenney, Mahrt, Sawyer and Wise; voting NO were Trustees None; absent or abstaining were None; whereupon the motion was declared adopted by the chairman.
- 6. Minutes of meeting held on May 4, 2015 were approved by unanimous consent.

9. Duane Grashorn, PeopleService, reported on the water and sewer systems. He recommended jetting and televising 8 sewer main areas where the camera went under water in the previous televising at a cost of \$4,000-\$5,000 to determine any needed repairs. It was moved by Trustee Borman, and seconded by Trustee Sawyer to have the 8 areas televised and jetted this fall. After discussion upon roll call vote, voting YES were Trustees Borman, Kenney, Mahrt, Sawyer, and Wise; voting NO were Trustees NONE; absent or abstaining were Trustees NONE; whereupon the motion was declared adopted by the presiding officer.

Grashorn also reported on work on the lagoon edge to repair washouts and holes from animals. This will be packed with clay and the work will be done this fall. The Board will send a letter to the DEQ with an update on this work and previously done mowing in response to their

John Peterson, JEO Consultants, presented an update on the Bank Stabilization project. He previous notice. will plan to attend the Woodcliff Lakes quarterly meeting on December 13, 2015 to inform residents of the project.

Don Schneider presented information on new Nebraska State legislation recently passed which outlines additional possible responsibilities for SIDs. No action was taken.

Chris Johannesen presented the Financial Reports for Fiscal Year End June 30, 2015 and 2015-2016 Fiscal Year-to-Date through August 31, 2015.

Johannesen also discussed the SiriusXM radar service which has been determined to be obsolete for Woodcliff Security purposes. The Board asked Johannesen to cancel the service.

#### 10. Old Business:

Mowing & Spraying of the riverbank by Schlosser Enterprises was done in June. No further work is needed ahead of the 2016 Bank Stabilization project.

The damages incurred at the well houses due to horses were discussed. The Board asked Johannesen to investigate the possibility of coverage by insurance.

#### 11. New Business:

A complaint about drainage in the area of S1018-S1021 and noise and damage by ATVs on the riverbank in the same area was discussed. This will be readdressed after the Bank Stabilization project is complete.

It was noted that Saunders County has mailed ballots for the 2015 SID election. Ballots must be mailed by September 15<sup>th</sup> to arrive at the County offices by the September 17<sup>th</sup>

Discussion of the Federal Disaster Mitigation Update was held. A motion was made by deadline. Trustee Wise and seconded by Trustee Kenney to adopt the attached Resolution Number 2015-02 for the Lower Platte North Natural Resources District Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan Update.

Whereupon a Motion for Adjournment was made by Trustee Wise, seconded by Trustee Kenney, and on roll call vote was unanimously approved by the Chairman and all Trustees, and declared duly adopted by the presiding officer, at which point the meeting adjourned.

### ORDINANCE NO. 2015-01

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE BUDGET STATEMENT TO BE TERMED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL; TO APPROPRIATE SUMS FOR NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND THE BOARD MEMBERS OF THE SANITARY AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 8 OF SAUNDERS COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. That after complying with all procedures required by law, the budget presented and set forth in the budget statement is hereby approved as the Annual Appropriation Bill for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2016.
